NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER
COMMON LAND UNIT CL 193, KNOWN AS COLLOWAY AND OVERTON MARSHES.
(APPLICATION REF NO. CA014)

This Notice is published on the County Council's website and served by email on those persons who have requested notification under Regulation 21 of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008 and served on other persons required to be so notified.

An application has been made to the Registration Authority, the Lancashire County Council of County Hall, Preston, Lancashire PR1 8XJ ('the Registration Authority') by Mr Alan John Bargh ('the Applicant') under Regulation 44 of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008 ('the Regulations').

The application seeks to amend the relevant entry in the rights section of CL193 to record a declaration of the Applicant's entitlement to exercise part of the right attached to Colloway Farm, Overton. The part right referred to is a right to graze 21 cattle and 7 sheep over CL193 known as Colloway and Overton Marshes. For the declaration to be made the Registration Authority will need to be satisfied that the supporting documents with the application has the effect of evidencing that the part of the land to which the right is attached is owned by the Applicant.

If the Registration Authority is satisfied that the evidence is sufficient it will accept the application and record the change of how the right is held.

The application and supporting documentation may be inspected between the hours of 9:00 am and 17:00 pm at the Office of the Chief Executive, Christ Church Precinct, County Hall, Preston PR1 8XJ.

Any person wishing to make representations or to object to the amendment of the register should send their representations or objections to the County Secretary & Solicitor, Lancashire County Council, P O Box 78, County Hall, Preston PR1 8XJ (Ref: LSG4/LM2/3.613) or by email to commonsandgreens@lancashire.gov.uk on or before 1st June 2012. Representations and objections must be made in accordance with Regulation 26 (1) and (2) of the Regulations and state the grounds on which they are made.

Any representations that are taken into account by the Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the Applicants for comment in accordance with Regulation 26 and may be disclosed to other interested parties. If the application is referred to the Planning Inspectorate for determination in accordance with Regulation 27 of the Regulations any representations will be sent to the Planning Inspectorate.
