## One person households, 2011 Census of Population

This short article contains one person household results from the 2011 Census of Population. The numbers have been downloaded from the <u>Office for National Statistics</u> website (census file KS105EW) and complement a range of other census data sets that have been added to our website. This article contains numbers and rates for one person households aged 65 and over and for under 65 years of age.

## The 2011 results for Lancashire

The Lancashire-14 area had 81,759 one-person households aged 65 and over, which represented 13.2% of all households. This was higher than the England and Wales percentage of 12.4%. In total, 16.9% of all households in Fylde had one person in this age-group, which was the 12<sup>th</sup> highest rate in England and Wales. Wyre is another Lancashire authority with a high proportion of older people and recorded the 19<sup>th</sup> highest rate (16.4%).

Blackburn with Darwen had just 10.9% of households with one person aged 65 or over, whilst Chorley, Preston and South Ribble were the other Lancashire authorities with percentages that were less than the national average.

There were 114,273 one-person households in the Lancashire-14 area in the under 65 years of age category, which represented 18.5% of all households (England and Wales = 17.8%). Preston and Blackpool, both with 23.0%, had large proportions of households in this category, whilst Burnley also had over 20% of households that

contained one person under 65. In contrast, much lower rates of below 15% were recorded in Ribble Valley, South Ribble and West Lancashire.
