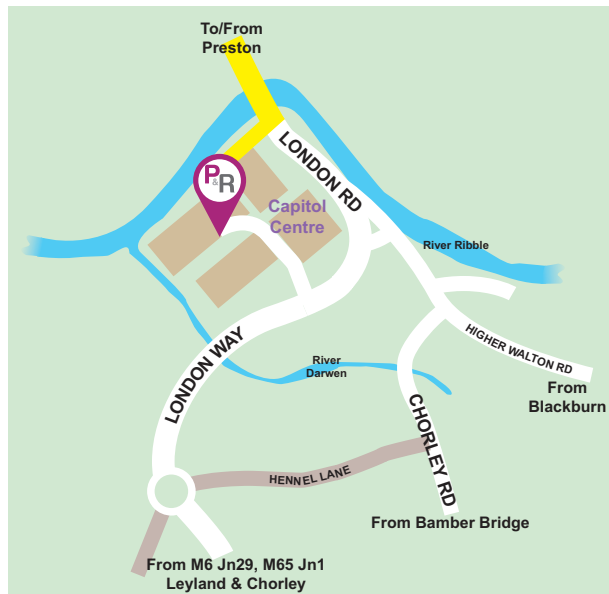

How to buy your Park and Ride ticket

Just buy your ticket from the driver on the Park and Ride bus.

Park and Ride Bus fares

Adult Return	£1.50
Adult Weekly Return	£6.00
Child Return	£0.75
Family Return	£3.00
Group Return	£4.00
Concessions/Disabled	FREE after 9.30am###

Families and groups benefit from discounted tickets

- Family Return - up to 2 adults travelling together with up to 3 children
- Group Return - up to 4 people travelling together in the same vehicle, returning at the same time.
- #Concessions - before 9.30am on Monday-Friday full adult fare applies. All other times are free of charge with a valid ENCTS card.
- ##Disabled - Disabled pass holders are subject to a 50p fare before 9:30am on Monday to Friday. All other times are free of charge with a valid disabled ENCTS card.



It is easy to use - simply park your car and the bus service takes you to the heart of the city, alighting/boarding at London Road and Jacson Street next to the Harris Museum/Library.
