- f) Only one latch, loop or other closing device will be attached to the gate(s)
- g) The surface of the public right of way through the gate(s) will maintained by the owner such that it is at least as good as the approaches to the gate(s).
- h) The top of the gate(s) will be no more than 1 metre from the ground
- i) The gate will conform to BS5709:2018
