The Short Break Service at Preston has been designed to cater for up to 6 people with Learning or Physical Disabilities who require a Short Break with specialised support facilities

The property is in close proximity to Preston Docklands a popular tourist destination with many amenities. There are 3 local parks, Ashton, Haslam & Moor, and The Preston Guild Wheel which is a 21 mile "greenway" that encircles Preston, linking the city to the countryside and bringing the benefits of a beautiful outdoor space to the city perimeter.
