KINROSS STREET AND AIRDRIE CRESCENT, BURNLEY BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Burnley Borough:
  - a. Kinross Street from its junction with Melrose Avenue to its junction with Airdrie Crescent.
  - b. Airdrie Crescent in a northerly direction only from its junction with Kinross Street to its junction with Melrose Avenue.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022 until 1700 hours on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **Motor vehicles travelling in a Southerly direction on Airdrie Crescent will be unaffected.**
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is;

Kinross Street - Airdrie Crescent - Melrose Avenue - Harold Street.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new housing development works to be carried out.
