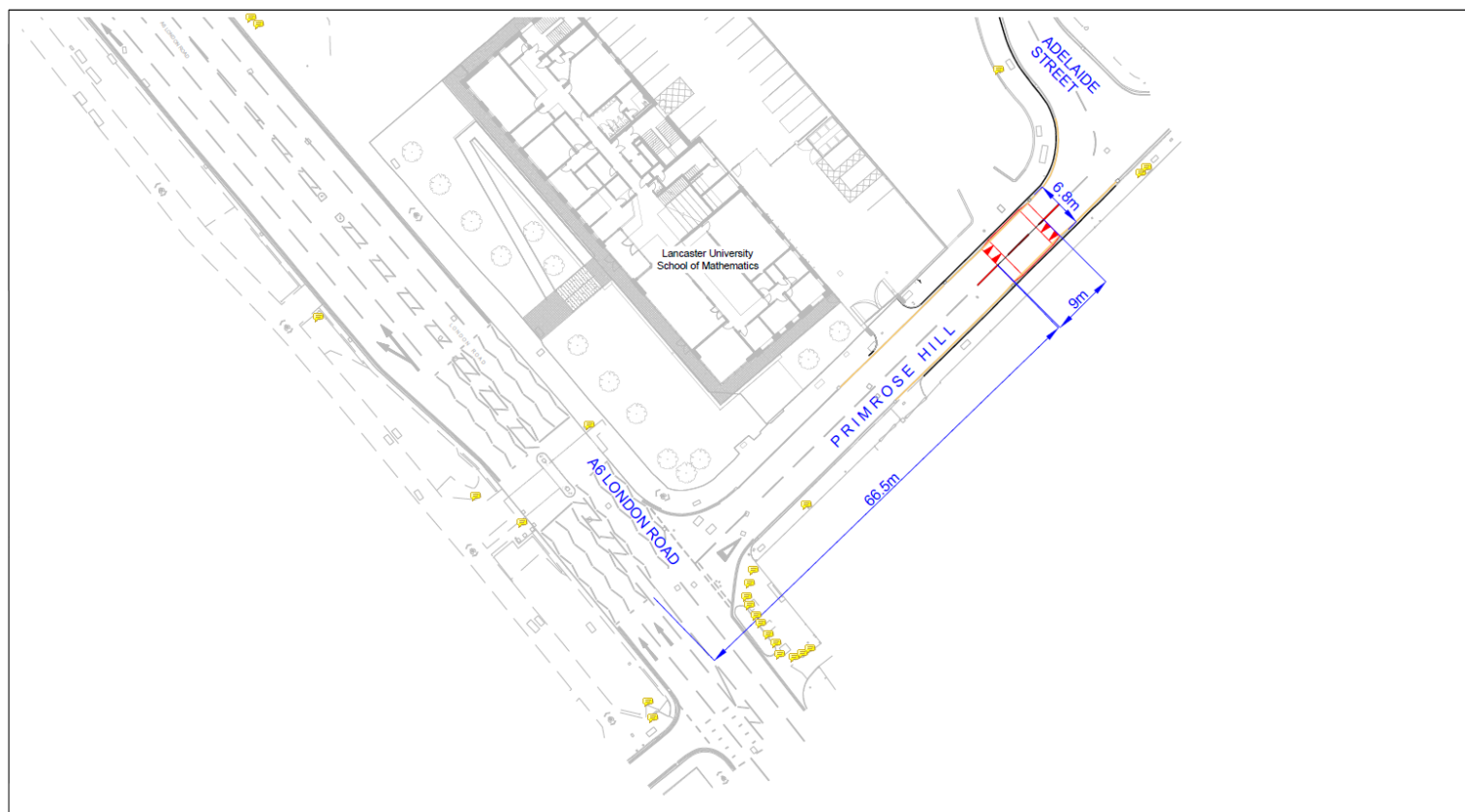


**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(PRIMROSE HILL, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)**  
**(SPEED HUMP)**



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a road hump in the Primrose Hill, Preston, from a point 66.5 metres north-east from its junction with the centreline of A6 London Road for a distance of 9 metres in an north easterly direction.

The speed humps will have a maximum height not exceeding 75mm.



**Statement of Reasons**

The requirements of the speed hump to be installed is due to the new development commencing in the area and is required to ensure vehicles slow down for pedestrians for highway safety reasons. These proposals are being funded by the Section 278 agreement monies deposited by the developer.
