

**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

**(HALTON ROAD, CHURCH BROW, HALTON,**  
**LANCASTER CITY)**  
**(ROAD HUMPS)**



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce speed cushions in the following locations:

- a) Halton Road, Halton, from a point 227 metres west from its junction with the centreline of Church Brow for a distance of 3.7 metres in an westerly direction;
- b) Halton Road, Halton, from a point 163 metres west from its junction with the centreline of Church Brow for a distance of 3.7 metres in an westerly direction;
- c) Halton Road, Halton, from a point 32 metres west from its junction with the centreline of Church Brow for a distance of 3.7 metres in an westerly direction;
- d) Church Brow, Halton, from a point 210 metres south west from its roundabout junction with Foundry Lane for a distance of 3.7 metres in an westerly direction;
- e) Church Brow, Halton, from a point 85 metres south west from its roundabout junction with Foundry Lane for a distance of 3.7 metres in an westerly direction.

The speed cushions will have a maximum height of 65 millimetres.

**Statement of Reasons**

To implement a 20mph Zone and Speed Cushions on Halton Road and Church Brow, Halton, Lancaster are due to speed related loss of control collisions through the village.


**Reasons Under Section 1 Of The RTRA**

For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising


