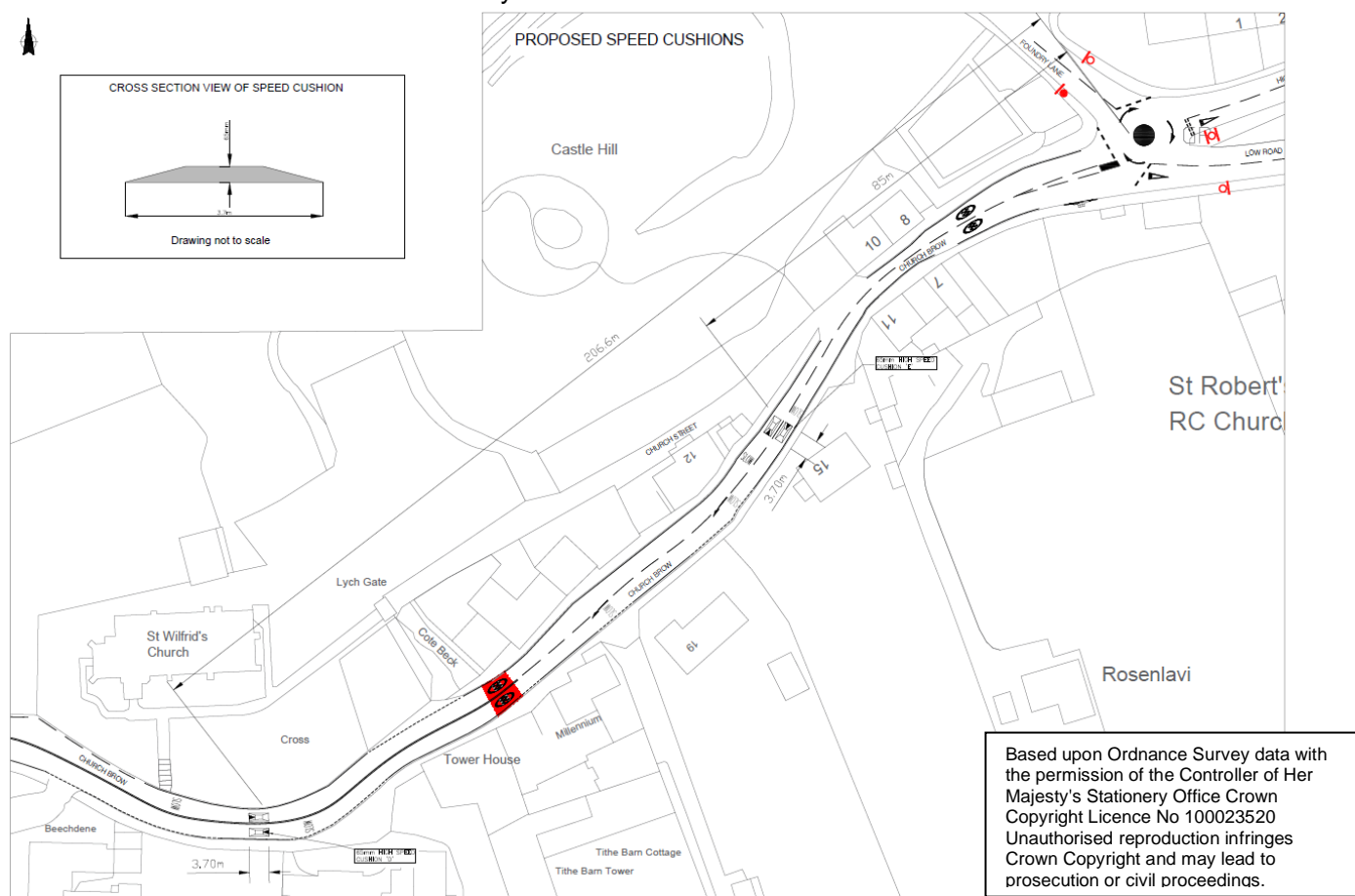


NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(HALTON ROAD, CHURCH BROW, HALTON, LANCASTER CITY)
(ROAD HUMPS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to introduce speed cushions in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**. Following consultation carried out between 02 March 2023 and 30 March 2023, it is now intended to modify the proposal as titled above, as set out below.

- a) Remove the speed cushions in the following location:
 - d) Church Brow Halton, from a point 210 metres south west from its roundabout junction with Foundry Lane for a distance of 3.7 metres in a westerly direction.
- b) Introduce speed cushions in the following location:
 - d) Church Brow, Halton, from a point 206.6 metres south west from its roundabout junction with Foundry Lane for a distance of 3.7 metres in a westerly direction.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of repositioning the speed cushions is to maintain a safe vehicular access and entry without any obstructions.
