
NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PRIORY CHASE, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(ROAD HUMPS)



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce speed cushions in the following locations:

- a) Priory Chase, Nelson, north eastern spur, from a point 20.3 metres south east of its northern junction with the centreline of Priory Chase for a distance of 3 metres in a south easterly direction;
- b) Priory Chase, Nelson, southern spur, from a point 14 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Priory Chase for a distance of 3 metres in a southerly direction.

The road humps will have a maximum height of 75mm.



## Statement of Reasons

The speed cushions are required to self-enforce the proposed 20mph speed limit and control vehicles speeds accessing and egressing the development to improve safety for all highway users including pedestrians. These proposals are being funded by Section 278 monies deposited by the developer and linked to the adjacent housing development.
