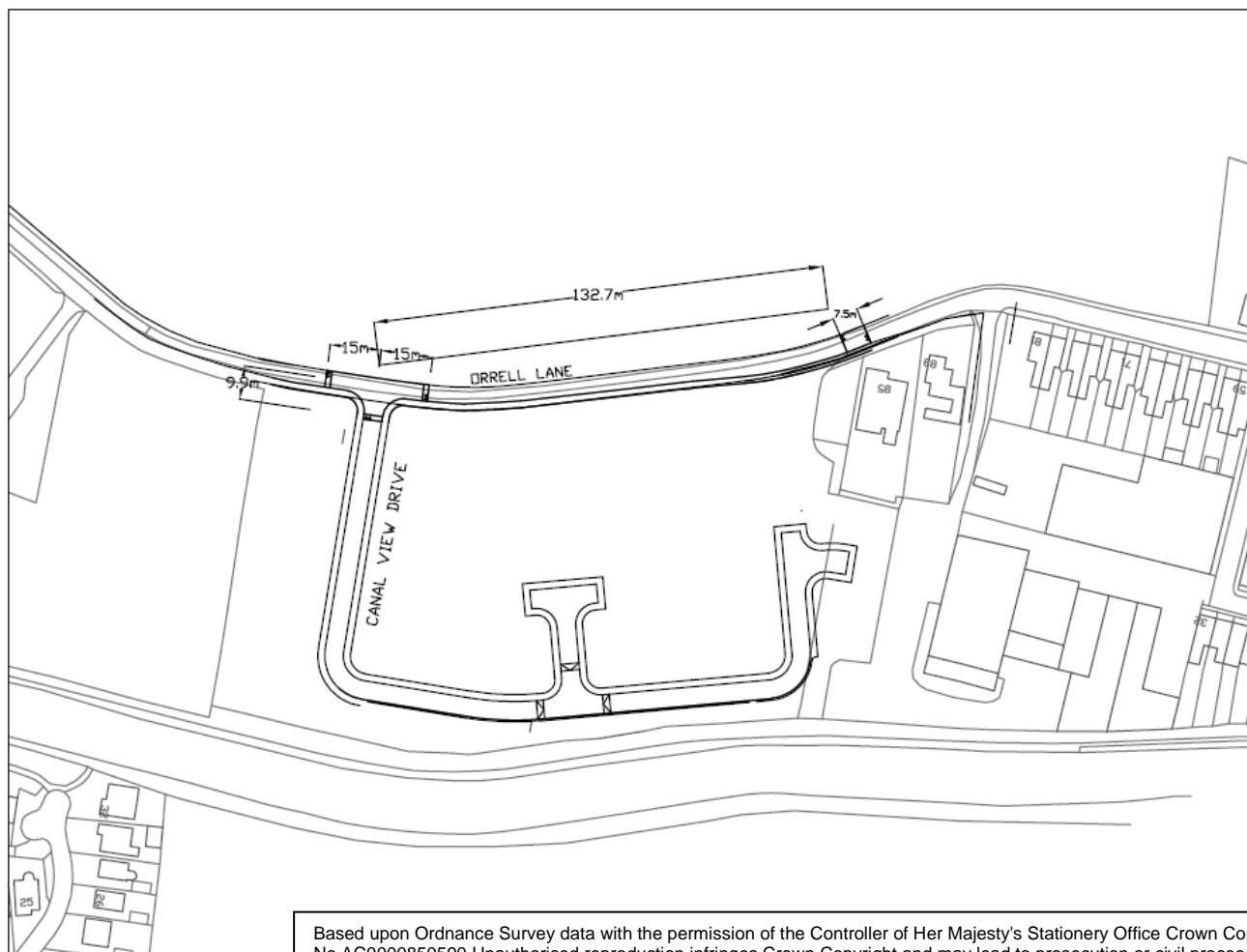


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CANAL VIEW DRIVE AND ORRELL LANE, BURSCOUGH, WEST
LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (ROAD HUMPS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce the following:

- 1) Introduce a junction table in the following location:
 - a) Orrell Lane, from the intersection of the centreline of Orrell Lane and Canal View Drive extending along Orrell Lane for 15 metres in both an easterly and westerly direction;
 - b) Canal View Drive, Burscough, from the intersection of the centreline of Orrell Lane and Canal View Drive extending along Canal View Drive in a southerly direction for a distance of 9.9 metres.
 - 2) Introduce a road hump on Orrell Lane, Burscough, from a point 132.7 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Canal View Drive for a distance of 7.5 metres in an easterly direction.
- The junction table and road hump will have a maximum height of 75mm.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of the proposed junction table and road hump is to improve the safety of motorised and non-motorised users, mitigating additional traffic flows from a new housing development on Orrell Lane with a reduction in the speed of vehicles passing the site and enforcement of the speed limit.

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development which will introduce further traffic movements at the junction of Orrell Lane.
