
NOTICE OF PROPOSAL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ACCESS ROAD TO NORTH BEACH CAR PARK AND TODMORDEN ROAD, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE **BOROUGH) (PRIORITY CROSSINGS)**



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above priority crossings under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce priority crossings in the following

- a) Todmorden Road, Lytham St Annes, from a point 9.5 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Clifton Drive North for a distance of 4.5 metres in a south westerly direction:
- b) Access Road to North Beach Car Park, Lytham St Annes, from a point 5 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Clifton Drive North for a distance of 4 metres in a south westerly direction.
