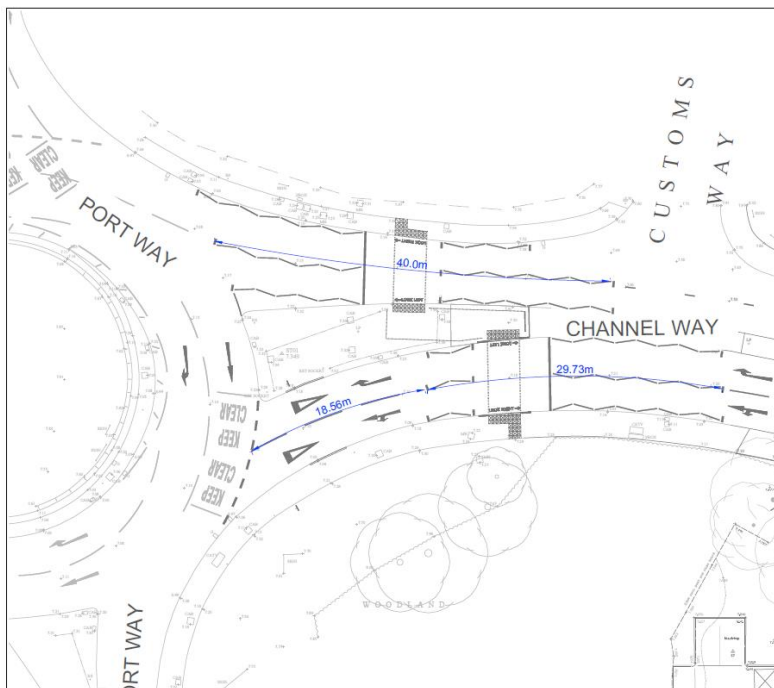


**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(CHANNEL WAY, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)**  
**(PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a puffin crossing in the following locations:

- a) Channel Way, Preston, the eastern carriageway, from its roundabout junction with Portway for a distance of 40 metres in an easterly direction;
- b) Channel Way, Preston, the western carriageway, from a point 18.56 metres east of its roundabout junction with Portway for a distance of 29.73 metres in an easterly direction.

### **Statement of Reasons**

The purpose of the proposed signalised crossing is to provide a safer, controlled pedestrian crossing with a refuge area, located near the vicinity of the development to encourage safe sustainable travel and promote social inclusion to and from the site.

The proposals are being pursued as part of a S278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a retail development which will introduce further traffic movements around Channel Way, Preston.
