
NOTICE OF PROPOSAL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (NEW STREET, MAWDESLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (ZEBRA CROSSING)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a zebra crossing in New Street, Mawdesley, from a point 86.16 metres north east of its centreline junction with High Street for a distance of 35.33 metres in a north easterly direction.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of the proposed New Zebra Crossing is to improve the safety of motorised and non-motorised users, to provide a clearly defined safe crossing area for pedestrians. This is located on a straight section of road to enable clear visibility and sightlines for drivers and pedestrians to make them aware of on-coming traffic/pedestrians wishing to cross in good time.

The proposals form part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development off Gorsey Lane which will increase traffic and pedestrian movements along New Street.
