## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (NELL LANE, CUERDEN, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (ROAD HUMPS)



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce road humps in the Nell Lane, Cuerden, from a point 28.5 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Wigan Road (A49) for a distance of 2.5 metres in an easterly direction. The road humps will have a maximum height of 75mm.



## **Statement of Reasons**

The proposals are being pursued as part of an s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development which will introduce further traffic movements at the junction of Stubbins Lane. "The purpose of the proposed Speed cushions is to help further enforce the proposed change of speed limit in the area to 20mph by providing this traffic-calming measure.
