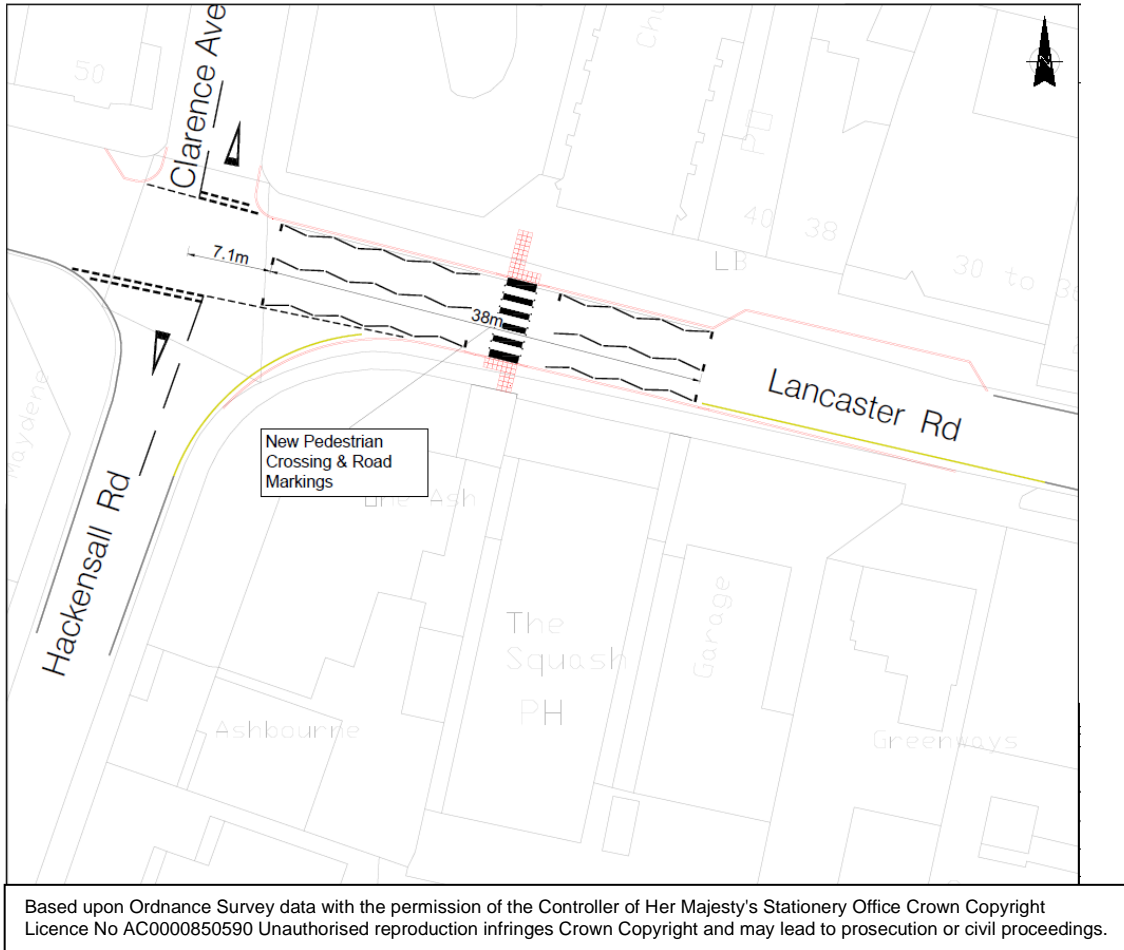


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LANCASTER ROAD, KNOTT END-ON-SEA, WYRE BOROUGH)
(PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a zebra crossing in Lancaster Road, Knott End-on-Sea, from a point 7.1 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Clarence Avenue/Hackensall Road for a distance of 38 metres in an easterly direction.



Statement of Reasons

A controlled crossing is proposed to increase the safety of pedestrians (particularly vulnerable young children or less mobile elderly pedestrians) crossing the carriageway. The crossing is proposed within close proximity to the nearby local amenities and places of worship because of the subsequent increase in the number of pedestrians wishing to cross the carriageway at this location. It is positioned at the optimum desire line but at a safe distance from conflicting traffic movements of the Hackensall Road junction.
