**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce speed cushions in the following locations:

- 1. Hoyles Lane, Woodplumpton, from a point 20 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Sandy Lane for a distance of 3 metres in a south westerly direction.
- 2. Hoyles Lane, Woodplumpton, from a point 77 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Sandy Lane for a distance of 3 metres in a north easterly direction.
- 3. Hoyles Lane, Woodplumpton, from a point 26.1 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Broadstone Road for a distance of 3 metres in a south westerly direction.

The speed cushions will have a maximum height not exceeding 75mm.

## **Statement of Reasons**

The purpose of the speed cushions along Hoyles Lane is to slow traffic and allow safe passage of pedestrians due to the increase in traffic from the new housing development. They are intended to slow traffic, creating a safer and more community friendly environment for pedestrians and other vulnerable user groups. These proposals are being funded by Section 278 monies by the developer and linked to the new housing development.
