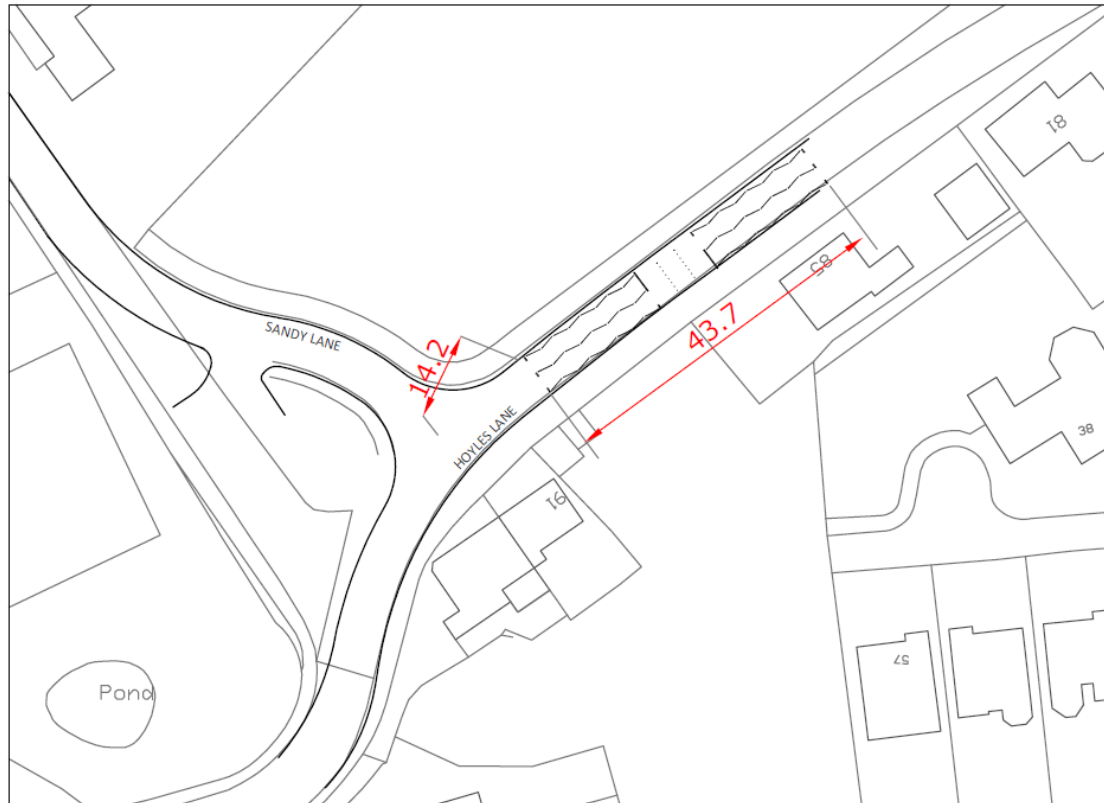


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(HOYLES LANE, WOODPLUMPTON, PRESTON CITY)
(PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a toucan crossing in Hoyles Lane, Woodplumpton, from a point 14.2 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Sandy Lane for a distance of 43.7 metres on a north easterly direction.

Statement of Reasons

This signalised toucan crossing is being proposed in order to provide a safe crossing point for pedestrians and cyclists on this section of carriageway of Hoyles Lane to link up with the existing footways and cycling network. The crossing is to be positioned at the optimum desire line but at the safe distance from the adjacent junction and will provide a safe crossing point.
