(TABLEY LANE AND TYNEHAM WAY, WOODPLUMPTON, PRESTON CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Tabley Lane and Tyneham Way, Woodplumpton as follows: -
 - Tabley Lane – from its junction with Hoyle's Lane to a point outside Nog Tow Cottages.
 - Tyneham Way – at the roundabout with Tabley Lane
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 12th February 2024 until 1600 hours on 26th March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Hoyle's Lane – Sandy Lane – William Young Way

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Cadent Gas to carry out gas mains reinforcement works.
