NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a zebra crossing in Whalley Road, Clayton-le-Moors, from a point 22.5 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Mill Entrance for a distance of 37.38 metres in a northerly direction.



Statement of Reasons

It is proposed to provide a zebra crossing on Whalley Road to provide safer road crossing facilities for pedestrians between the proposed development and the existing schools, businesses and bus stops on the eastern side of Whalley Road

The proposals are being pursued as part of a Section 278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development on the West side of Whalley Road to improve pedestrian links to the east side of Whalley Road.
