## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (NEW ROAD, EARBY, PENDLE BOROUGH) (ROAD HUMPS)

- c) New Road, Earby, from a point 51 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Green End Avenue for a distance of 6 metres in a north westerly direction;
- d) New Road, Earby, from a point 7 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Green End Avenue for a distance of 6 metres in a south easterly direction.
