(WOODHILL LANE, MORECAMBE, LANCASTER CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Woodhill Lane, Morecambe from its junction with West End Road to its junction with Kenwood Avenue.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0800 hours and 1700 hours from Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2024 until Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
West End Road – Acre Moss Lane – Kenwood Avenue and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out.
