NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Blackpool Road, Preston from its junction with Garstang Road to its junction with Woodplumpton Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative nightly from 2000 hours until 0800 hours on 2nd April 2024 until 12th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Blackpool Road – Tulketh Road – West Strand – Ring Way – North Road – Garstang Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out carriageway improvement works.
