(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear 52-86 Victoria Road West & Gable 86 Victoria Road West, Thornton Cleveleys from the junction with Runnymede Avenue to the rear of 66 Victoria Road West (Costa Coffee).
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative **nightly** from 2200 hours until 0400 hours on Monday 8th April 2024 until Wednesday 10th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Not Applicable – back alley is to be closed when businesses are closed and no deliveries are being made

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow fibre connection works to be carried out on behalf of Next Generation Networks.
