NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Town Lane, Much Hoole from its boundary with Fernbank for 50 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 9th April 2024 until 1700 hours on Thursday 11th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access to be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Smithy Lane - Liverpool Old Road - Liverpool Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilites.
