(GHANTS LANE & CHURCH LANE, HAMBLETON, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of road in the Borough of Wyre:
 - Ghants Lane from its junction with Cutts Lane for approximately
 185 metres in a northerly direction.
 - ii. Church Lane from its junction with Ghants Lane for approximately 225 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 15th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Marsh Lane – Sower Carr Lane – Clay Gap Lane – Knitting Row Lane - Cutts Lane – Mill Lane – Moss Lane – Grange Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access to the underground structure for works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
