NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Raglan Road, Burnley from its junction with St. Matthew Street to its junction with Scarlett Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Thursday 8th April 2024 until 1800 hours on Friday 12th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

St. Matthew Street – Alwin Street – Scarlett Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow water valve replacement works to be carried out.
