(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Raglan Road, Burnley from its junction with St. Matthew Street to its junction with Scarlett Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2024 until 1800 hours on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

St. Matthew Street – Alwin Street – Scarlett Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow water valve replacement works to be carried out.
