
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Borwick Lane, Warton from to its junction with A6 Scotland Road for a distance of approximately 50 metres in a south easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Tuesday 2nd April 2024 until 1700 hours on Tuesday 9th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
A6 Burton Road – Chapel Lane – Tewitfield Lane – Borwick Lane
and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow electrical connection works to be carried out.
