(HOLLINS LANE, FORTON, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Hollins Lane, Forton from the entrance to the sewage works for approximately 50 metres in a north-westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 20th May 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 31st May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Anyon Lane – Chipping Lane – Gleaves Hill Lane – Gleaves Hill

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow cable installation and jointing works for HV mains connection to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of ENW.
