(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of North Drive, Thornton Cleveleys from its junction with Northumberland Avenue to outside house number 656.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1800 hours on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2024 until Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Northumberland Avenue – Sunderland Avenue

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway inlay works to be carried out by LCC Highways.
