NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Joe Lane, Catterall from its junction with Garstang Bypass Road to its junction with Newhaven Drive.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 8th April 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 14th June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Garstang Bypass Road – Cock Robin Lane – Garstang Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow private Section 278 drainage and resurfacing works to be carried out by Argyle NW Construction Ltd.
