NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Wesley Street, Bamber Bridge from its junction with Station Road to its junction with Stockdale Crescent.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0900 hours until 1500 hours on Monday 15th April 2024 until Friday 26th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access to be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Station Road – Mounsey Road – Stockdale Crescent – Vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway inlay works to be carried out by LCC Highways.
