(U613 BIRCH GREEN ROAD, SKELMERSDALE, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed in a Southbound direction over that length of U613 Birch Green Road, Skelmersdale from a point 175m South of its junction with U49446 Forest Grove, Skelmersdale for a distance of 25m in a Southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Thursday 18th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for cyclists will be maintained on foot.**
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U613 Birch Green Road, Skelmersdale – A577 Houghtons Road,
Skelmersdale – U608 Northway, Skelmersdale –
U613 Birch Green Road, Skelmersdale.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecoms mast testing works to be carried out by Chevron Traffic Management on behalf of Vodafone.
