(GHANTS LANE, HAMBLETON, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Ghants Lane, Hambleton from its junction with Church Lane for approximately 800 metres in a north-easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours to 1630 hours on Thursday 16th May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Clay Gap Lane – Knitting Row Lane – Cutts Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow a safe working area to excavate and provide new ducting to be carried out by BT Openreach.
