(GHANTS LANE, HAMBLETON, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Ghants Lane, Hambleton from its junction with Church Lane for approximately 800 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours to 1630 hours on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Clay Gap Lane - Knitting Row Lane - Cutts Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow a safe working area to excavate and provide new ducting to be carried out by BT Openreach.
