(BATH MILL LANE, LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bath Mill Lane, Lancaster from its junction with Moor Lane for a distance of approximately 20 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-N/A – No Through Route. Access for pedestrians and emergency services will be maintained.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access for works to be carried out on behalf of Openreach.
