

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
(PINCOCK STREET, CHORLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Pincock Street, Chorley from its boundary with Riversdale to its boundary with Waterside House.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2024 until 1800 hours on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access to be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

No diversion as this is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow fire hydrant installation works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilites.
