**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Taylors Meanygate, Tarleton from its junction with Legh Lane, travelling in a northerly direction for approximately 30 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1500 hours on 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024 until 2359 hours on 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Open Reach to carry out urgent works to their assets.
