- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Back Bethel Street, Barnoldswick from the rear of number 8 Bethel Street to its junction with Skipton Road.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1300 hours on Sunday 21st April 2024 until 2359 hours on Thursday 25th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent water pipe repair works to be carried out.
