(MARKET STREET, HAMBLETON, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Market Street, Hambleton from its junction with Pauls Lane to its junction with Arthurs Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> August 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for motor vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible and for pedestrians at all times.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Sandy Lane – Marsh Lane – Church Lane – Arthurs Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to install and joint cable for mains connection to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of ENW.
