(WOODHART LANE, ECCLESTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Woodhart Lane, Eccleston from its junction with Bannister Lane for 75 metres in a north easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1800 hours on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May until Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access to be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Bannister Lane - Woodhart Lane - Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow duct installation works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
