(CHAPEL LANE, HEAPEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Chapel Lane, Heapey from its boundary with Moorby House for 50 metres in a south easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours to 1700 hours on Tuesday 18th June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Tithe Barn Lane - Heapey Road - Knowley Brow - Blackburn Brow - A674

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilites.
