(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

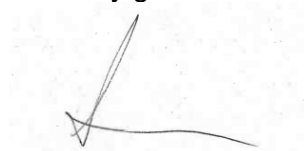
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. Horrobin Lane, Anderton from its junction with Roscoe Lowe Brow, Anderton to its merging with Horrobin Lane, Rivington.
 - II. Horrobin Lane, Rivington from its merging with Horrobin Lane, Anderton for a distance of 348 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0900 hours until 1500 hours on Wednesday 23rd September 2026 until Thursday 24th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Horrobin Lane - Roscoe Lowe Brow – Rivington Lane - A673 Bolton Road – Dryfield Lane – Rivington Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway pre-surface dressing patching works to be carried out.
