This Notice is published on the County Council's web site and served by email on those persons who have requested notification under Regulation 21 of the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008 and served on other persons required to be so notified.

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others whom it may concern.

Lancashire County Council as the Registration Authority has made a proposal under Section 19 (2) (a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008.

The proposal seeks to correct a mistaken omission by the Commons Registration Authority in amending register CL65YR entry number 3. An application was made to the Registration Authority for the amendment of the Register of Common Land, Notices were served on all interested parties and, no objections having been received, an amendment was duly recorded in the Register of Common Land. Despite the application referring throughout to "The Rights to be held in Gross" the register was amended to show the rights as being attached to the Land. If the proposal is approved this will record the correct details in the register, showing the rights as being held in gross.

The proposal may be inspected at Lancashire County Council, the Office of the Chief Executive, Christ Church Precinct, County Hall, Preston PR1 8XJ between the hours of 9.00 am and 17.00 pm Monday to Friday.

Representations and objections must be made in accordance with regulation 26 (1) and (2) of the Regulations and state the grounds on which they are made.

Representations cannot be treated as confidential, but will be dealt with in accordance with Regulation 26. If the proposal is referred to the Planning Inspectorate for determination in accordance with Regulation 27 of the Regulations any representations will be sent to the Planning Inspectorate.
