(FOUR LANE ENDS ROAD, STACKSTEAD, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Four Lane Ends Road, Stackstead from outside property number 31 for 10 meters in either direction.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0840 hours on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2026 until 2359 hours on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent excavation of the carriageway to repair a leaking service works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
