(PRESTON ROAD, CROSSMOOR, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Preston Road, Crossmoor from its junction with Hornby Lane to its junction with Watery Gate Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on Thursday 24th September 2026 until Friday 25th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Carrs Green – Lewth Lane – Moorside Lane – Woodplumpton Lane – Whittingham Lane – James Towers Way – Garstang Road – Tamacre Lane – Blackpool Road – Garstang Road – Fleetwood Road – Thistleton Road – High Street – Lodge Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole replacement works to be carried out by BT
