(ABBEYSTED LANE, DOLPHINHOLME, LANCASTER CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Abbeystead Lane, Dolphinholme Lancaster from its junction with Gleaves Hill Lane, Dolphinholme to outside property number 1
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.

The prohibition will be operative from 1530 hours on Friday 31st July 2026 until 1800 hours on Monday 3rd August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.

3. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation of the carriageway to repair consequential damage. Works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
