(REAR 35-77 MELVILLE STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of 35 to 77 Melville Street, Burnley from its junction with Eastern Avenue for 20 meters in a Northerly direction.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0925 hours on Tuesday 22nd September 2026 until 2359 hours on Saturday 26th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent excavation of the carriageway to repair a sewer works to be carried out by Sapphire Wastewater on behalf of United Utilities.
