LEA LANE AND BLACKLEACH LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of road;
 - i. Lea Lane from its junction with Bartle Lane to its junction with Blackleach Lane.
 - ii. Blackleach Lane from its junction with Lea Lane to its junction with Treales Road.
2. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Wednesday 21st October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
3. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Edith Rigby Way – William Young Way – Tabley Lane – Woodplumpton Road – Moorside Lane – School Lane – Catforth Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out.
